Leader. God, the Father of mercies,
has reconciled the world to himself through the death and resurrection of
his Son, Jesus Christ,
not holding our sins against us,
but sending his Holy Spirit to shed abroad his love among us.
We pray that we receive his pardon and peace to stand before him in his
strength alone this day and for evermore. **All Amen.**

We present to you these symbols of care for our bodies. .

As we use them now with faith in your healing power,
may we and all for whom we pray,
know freedom from suffering and distress,
find inward peace,
and the joy of your salvation,
through your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen**
